## SPECIAL ABILITIES

**A Sure Thing** (1/day) 1/day, +2 to hit an evil creature.  
**Improved Unarmed Strike** Unarmed strikes don't cause attacks of opportunity, and can be lethal.  
**Martial Maneuvers** (1/day) (Ex) Spend a move action to gain the benefit of a combat feat for 1 minute.  
**Throw Anything** Proficient with improvised ranged weapons. +1 to hit with thrown splash weapons.

**Unarmed Strike** (1d6) The Brawler does lethal damage with his unarmed strikes.
